

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.15) Order 2021

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council has made the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order:

1. To revoke the 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' bays on the following lengths of roads in the District of Tendring:

Road	Description
Manor Road, Harwich	NORTH-EAST SIDE: From a point in line with the common boundary of property No. 9 & 11 Manor Road, north-westwards for approx. 5.0 metres. Substitute Tile ref: TM240 310 revision 1 to 2
Manor Road, Harwich	NORTH-EAST SIDE: From the southern boundary of property No. 17 Manor Road, north-westwards for approx. 6.6 metres. Substitute Tile ref: TM245 310 revision 0 to 1
London Road, Clacton	SOUTH-WEST SIDE: From the western boundary of property No. 41 London Road, south-eastwards for approx. 6.6 metres. Substitute Tile ref: TM170 157 revision 0 to 1

2. To revoke a 'Disabled Badge Holders Only' bay, to reinstate a corresponding section of 'Permit Parking Area WH1' (aka Permit Holders Only) on the following length of road in the District of Tendring:

Road	Description
Watson Road, Clacton	NORTH-WEST SIDE: From the common boundary of property No. 5A & 7 Watson Road, south-westwards for approx. 6.6 metres Substitute Tile ref: TM170 150 revision 2 to 3

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting tile numbers TM170 157, TM245 310 revision (rev) 0 to rev 1, TM240 310 rev 1 to rev 2, TM170 150 rev 2 to rev 3.

Date of operation: The Order will come into operation on **1 July 2021**.

Application to the high court: Anyone who wishes to question the validity of the Order of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
